Schedule L, Part IV - On July 2 2007, Dick Randall donated \$795,036, the amount required to purchase a new Lighthouse teen residence at 781 Avelar, East Palo Alto, to replace the outgrown Lighthouse facility at 136 Aster Way in East Palo Alto owned by NCHM. At the time of the purchase of 781 Avelar, a 0% note obligation was entered by NCHM in favor of Mr. Randall for the difference between the \$795,036 cash Mr Randall donated to NCHM for the purchase Avelar, and the future sale proceeds from Aster, which donation was to provide continuity in the program, allowing the Lighthouse program to be moved from 136 Aster to 781 Avelar, after which the Aster Way property could be sold. In late 2007, 136 Aster Way was placed on the market for \$599,009, but shortly afterwards, the sub-prime lending crisis caused a disruption in market conditions, and the Aster Way home was taken off the market, as the local area was flooded with foreclosures and short sales. On July 20, 2010, Aster way was sold for \$349,600, which proceeds were disbursed to Mr. Randall, along with with \$80,000 from NCHM which was raised in a capital campaign related to the purchase of the new Lighthouse site. In addition to the sale proceeds of \$349,436 and \$80,000, a donation receipt for Mr. Randall's donation of \$365,436 (\$795,036 - \$349,600 - \$80,000) was provided at the time of the sale of Aster way.
